Dr. Ray will be speaking on Monday, February 9th at Sacred Heart Shrine in Bowmansville and on Tuesday, February 10th as part of Theology on Tap at Dave and Busters (see the inside ad for all the details).

For both nights Dr. Ray is calling his talk: "Why Be Catholic?" However, each night will have a different emphasis that is tailored to the crowd. The talk on the 9th is open to all ages and will focus more on how to help bring fallen-away family members back to the Church. The following night at Theology on Tap, which is a Catholic speaker series for young adults in their twenties and thirties, he'll focus more on how to wade through the popular culture to see the brilliance and beauty of the Church. If you're part of the older crowd, like myself, then Monday night is the talk that will best fit your needs. If you're under 40, Tuesday's Theology on Tap is probably the best fit for you. All are invited to come see Dr. Ray while he's in town and there will be no charge to get in to either talk, but we will take up a goodwill offering.

On another note, we have made some changes to our Saturday program schedule this month. We have moved Quiet Waters Production's Music Hour to 1pm and Praying Twice to 2pm. These programs will be followed by The Chaplet of Divine Mercy in Song and The Holy Rosary. This will be a fantastic Saturday afternoon music and prayer block for you to enjoy. On Saturday night we are featuring a few new programs. From 9-10pm we'll be playing our new Ascension Press Theology of the Body Hour. Ascension Press has graciously given us access to their best new audio programs to gradually immerse you in Pope John Paul the Great's teachings on God's awesome plan for human sexuality. From 10-10:30pm we'll play the top Christian music of the day on Top of the Charts. Finally, from 10:30-11pm you can hear The Pure Life, a dynamic series from Jason and Crystalina Evert that helps to build us up in virtue and encourages us to answer God's call to holiness with a resounding 'yes!' "Calls": From the Message of Fatima By | Sister Lucia

Mary knows that this prophecy (Is. 53:1-10) is to be fulfilled in the person of her Son; she knows that He has been sent by God to carry out the work of our redemption. And far from wanting to save Him from such pain and suffering, she takes Him in her pure arms, brings Him to the temple with her virginal hands and places Him on the altar so that the priest may offer Him to the eternal Father as an expiatory victim and a sacrifice of praise (in the mystery of the presentation of Jesus).

Here, Mary does not simply offer her Son, she offers herself with Christ, because Jesus had received his body and blood from her; thus she offers herself in and with Christ to God, co-Redemptrix, with Christ, of humanity.

In this mystery of the presentation of Jesus, the pure hands of Mary are the first paten on which God placed the first host; and, from this paten, the priest on duty in the temple of Jerusalem took it, to place it on the altar and offer it to the Father as something which is owed to Him and an offering with which He is well pleased. Here we have a figure; later will come the real Mass, when the sacrifice of expiation will be consummated on Calvary; Jesus, by His own hands, will offer Himself to the Father for men, under the consecrated species of bread and wine, saying to the priests of the New Covenant: "Do this in remembrance of me" (Lk. 22:19), that is, offer My sacrifice to the Father so that it will be renewed on the altar for the salvation of the world. Because "This is my body which is given for you... This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood" (Lk. 22:19-20).



"CALLS" From the Message of Fatima is a long letter, written entirely by Sr. Lucia, a visionary of the apparitions in Fatima, Portugal. Sister Lucia asked the Holy See for permission to write a text in which she could reply in general to the many questions that had been put to her. Permission was granted and this text is the result.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Paragraph #2205

The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit. In the procreation and education of children it reflects the Father's work of creation. It is called to partake of the prayer and sacrifice of Christ. Daily prayer and the reading of the Word of God strengthen it in charity. The Christian family has an evangelizing and missionary task.

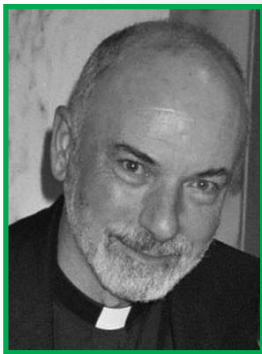
