"Calls": From the Message of Fatima By | Sister Lucia

It is true that keeping the word of God involves self-denial and renunciation, but it is also true that it is precisely in this self-denial and renunciation that we prove our love to God: "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me" (Mk. 8:34).

The world, on the other hand, promises an easy life and pleasure, and surrounds us with many enticing temptations, but they are false and are born of ignorance because the world, or rather those who follow the maxims of the world, do not know the value of the good thing they are rejecting and losing when they turn their backs on God. They are all in search of happiness, but they do not find it, because they are looking for it where it is not to be found, and so, since they are on the wrong road, the further they go along it the further they go from happiness.

God is the only Being where happiness is to be found, for which, moreover, we were created. But God is not to be found in the satisfaction of the sensual pleasures of the flesh and of the senses, nor of the passions of pride, self-esteem, covetousness, etc. God is to be found in pure souls, in humble hearts and upright consciences, free from attachment to the things of the earth, such as honors, pleasures, riches, etc. People of this kind identify themselves with God, and the life of God in them; and He communicates to them an ever increasing share in his gifts (p.122).

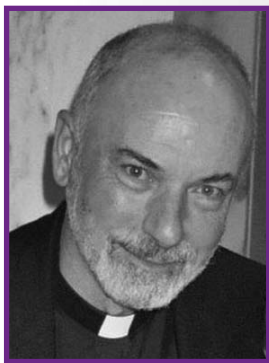
